\* Tuition payment of \$750 is due at the end of each of the Class Weekends. There will be a charge for clinical days to be determined, as the length of the clinical experience is individual. This tuition estimate does not include the cost of courses provided by ITEA, but outside the Practitioner Track curriculum.

Tuition for additional coursework taken within the ITEA program is as follows:

- Nutrition for Clients = \$315
- Pharmacology = \$600/year for three years, totaling \$1,800
- Pathology = \$660
- Western Medical Tests = \$145
- Zero Balancing = \$660
